The Johnsons started having housing problems two years ago after Ms. Johnson was forced out of work due to a sudden medical condition. She fell behind on rent and their family was evicted. They had to live in a hotel at an expensive cost of \$1,700 a month.

That's where you stepped in.

The Johnsons were offered temporary housing at Thompson's campus and assigned an ACP social worker. We would not be able to offer this kind of arrangement if it wasn't for your support. Her social worker connected her with community resources to help find stable housing and they successfully moved in at the end of 2020.
