## Early Childhood

- Thompson Child Development Center is serving over 73 children on any given day.
- Thompson is sending 3 new therapists through PCIT Training this Spring (Parent Child Interaction Training) through Duke University.
- Thompson recently sent several early childhood professionals through Triple P training specific for early childhood settings and became certified as PECE (Positive Early Childhood Education) Coaches. This represents Thompson continuing to be a leader in the infant mental health space in our community.
- We invested over \$20,000 into the interior at our Child Development Center including fresh paint and furniture for classrooms.

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## Mental Health



- Completion of a \$35k renovation of Kenan Cottage, home to a program that serves young men that are involved in both the child welfare & juvenile justice systems. The renovation was funded by our donors/supporters. See photos to the right.
- CMS Turning Point Academy (TPA) reported positive outcomes for the participating youth. Compared to the years prior to this partnership, TPA students now have higher attendance rates, fewer behavior incidents after returning to their home schools, and lower rates of reassignment to TPA within two academic years. - Awarded \$100k for [High Fidelity Wraparound](#) expansion – we will be expanding outside of Mecklenburg county into the Catawba/Iredell area.
