Single mother w/2 children. Mother became ill and was unable to work. She eventually received disability income but was evicted for non-payment of rent. The family had been bouncing between family and friends and then ACP was able to place them in transitional housing. This allowed mom to save money and seek income-based housing. When she secured housing ACP assisted with move-in fees & rented a truck to assist with moving - \$2500.



Single mom with one young child. They were living in a motel when they first enrolled in ACP. She was able to move to a transitional living facility which allowed her to save some money. Mom worked on building a client list and increasing sales with Mary Kay. ACP was able to assist mom with move-in expenses. Her daughter starts Kindergarten this school year. This is a young mother and it's her first time having her own place. Assistance with first months rent and deposit: \$2300



Family who lost housing due to father being incarcerated. Mom and 3 children moved into a hotel and could not afford to get out. The weekly cost of the hotel room left them with no way to save for moving expenses. ACP was able to provide \$2300 for first months rent and deposit. Mom exited the ACP program with housing and set the goal for herself to get a driver's license and eventually a car for herself.



Single mother with 2 young children who lost housing due to financial strain from medical bills incurred and inability to work during this time. ACP/Thompson helped mom to get into transitional housing so that she could live rent free and pay off bills. She was also able to return to work during this time so when she found housing we were able to assist her with move-in expenses - \$2400 for first months rent & deposit.



Single mom with 2 young daughters. Mom was unable to work due to Covid. ACP social worker assisted the parent with applying for Covid-relief funding but hadn't heard back in time for the rent payment to be made. ACP paid one month's rent - \$1200 — which allowed the family to stay in their home and not accrue debt.
