HEALTH GAINS



Early Childhood



Children are more successful when parents are actively involved throughout their lives, but their involvement is most critical in the early years. This model serves children ages 0-5 and their families. A Clinician provides child/parent psychotherapy and a Family Resource Partner links the family to services to meet their basic needs. By addressing both practical and clinical needs, Child First helps break the cycle of generational trauma.

- Our <u>Placement Stability Unit</u> case management program is having a positive impact on difficult to place youth in Upstate South Carolina. (see data in blue box)
- Fiscal year to date (FYTD), our <u>Family Education</u> client satisfaction rate hit 98% and Family Partners clients reached 100% family functioning gains.
- Friends of the Children Charlotte youth met all roadmap goals in Q2 and have a 96% client satisfaction rating FYTD.



Foster Care

- Licensed 340 foster homes across North Carolina.
- Our first <u>Treatment Foster Care Oregon</u> (TFCO) youth successfully exited the program and is on track to graduate high school this summer.
- Both foster parents and foster youth had 100% client satisfaction scores through the end of 2022.
- Our foster youth had 99% placement stability meaning no more than 2 placements while being fostered.

Mental Health

- <u>Early Childhood Mental Health, Outpatient Therapy, School-Based Therapy, Family Centered Treatment, Intensive In-Home, and High-Fidelity Wraparound</u> clients all measured at or above target goal for mental health gains in December.
- 100% of youth discharged from <u>Multisystemic Therapy</u> (MST) in Upstate SC through December had no new arrests, were living at home, and were attending school at the close of their treatment.
- Thompson was one of three agencies in NC selected to participate in Modular Approach to Therapy for Children with Anxiety, Depression, Trauma, or Conduct Problems (MATCH-ADTC), an evidence-based practice for children ages 6 15. Training for our therapists begins in March and this new clinical treatment will positively impact the children and families we serve.





- Our new Enhanced Residential Treatment Center (ERTC) launched.
 The goal is to reduce the duration of residential care by working with the family through Family Centered Treatment and/or High-Fidelity Wraparound to ultimately prepare and support the family for the youth's successful discharge back to their home environment.
- Youth in our <u>Crisis Stabilization Program</u> (CSP) reached a 92% satisfaction rate through the end of 2022.

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
