

FOSTER CARE

Children are coming into foster care in record numbers and often they are being moved to counties far away from the area they know and love. Thompson's Foster Care program has grown as we address this demand.

TYPES OF FOSTER CARE

Traditional Foster Care – children & youth ages 0-21, who are in need of a loving & stable home.

Medically Fragile Foster Care – children & youth ages 0-21, with additional medical needs, requiring a foster home equipped to support those needs. **Therapeutic Foster Care** – children & youth ages 0-21, who are in need of interventions/treatment to help with them be successful.

Treatment Foster Care-Oregon (TFCO) – short-term (6-9 months) placement for high needs youth ages 7-18 providing daily therapeutic support for the youth and family.

Transitional Foster Care - youth stepping down from a higher level of care who need a safe and structured home to practice their life skills before moving to a regular therapeutic home; typical stay is 30-60 days.

Professional Foster Parents - Foster parents who can commit to working with therapeutic foster children and their identified permanent placement for 90-180 days before reunification. Foster parents are paid a salary vs. a stipend for this program

Respite Foster Care - Short-term care for another foster family's foster child, providing them with a break, or allowing them to attend an obligation.




