## Helping maintain all types of placements for at-risk youth

## What is TPSU?

The Thompson Placement Stabilization Unit (TPSU) program surrounds difficult-to-place teens with a team committed and equipped to bring stability into their story. In partnership with DSS, each team is customized to address the needs of the community it serves.



## What can TPSU do for you?

Our goal is to support youth and their families through mentoring, coaching, counseling, support, crisis intervention, and basic care coordination.

After receiving a referral, TPSU will make contact with Case Managers within 24 hours and have services in place within the following 48 hours.

- Any adoption, family preservation, or investigations cases.
