Our team works with families to identify goals and chart a path to reach them.

we support families

- Advocacy/assistance in identifying needs or benefits
- Access to food/food stamps
- Assistance with job search/job security support
- Accessing after school programs/care for children
- Connecting to other Thompson services, prosocial activities, psych testing, and medical providers in the community
- McKinney-Vento referral to support students and their family experiencing homelessness
- Safety planning or behavior support planning

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
